Research and Writing: KAMS/AMS students will enroll in a Research and Writing course (GSCI 376) and three credit hours of research during the fall or spring semesters. The students in these courses will work on a research project facilitated by a mentor. KAMS/AMS students will be required to submit and present their research via a poster session or other communication format deemed appropriate by the mentor at a research forum. The forum, to be determined by the mentor, may be the Regional Science and Engineering Fair, the Regional Junior Academy of Sciences, and/or the FHSU Scholarly & Creative Activities Day poster presentations or another similar event, (i.e. Kansas Academy of Science meeting).
