What is an ESOL Endorsement

An English for Speakers of Other Languages Endorsement is an add-on endorsement to a valid Kansas teaching license. It is available for K-6, 6-12, or PreK-12. Questions regarding ESOL Endorsement programs should be directed to Teacher Licensure at KSDE.

Complete an approved ESOL program in Kansas

- Hold a currently valid Kansas teaching license or as part of initial application
- Pass the appropriate Praxis content assessment

- Valid out-of-state license or certificate must have been issued by the appropriate state.
- Pass the appropriate Praxis content assessment

- Hold a currently valid Kansas teaching license
- Pass the appropriate Praxis content assessment
