

School Transportation Provider Disclosure

Kansas law, KAR 91-38-6, requires each prospective school transportation provider to sign a statement concerning their criminal and driving record histories. "School transportation provider" is defined as anyone who drives a school bus or activity bus to transport Kansas students. It also includes an individual hired primarily to provide transportation for Kansas students with a school passenger vehicle. A school district or school transportation contractor may use their own form for this legal requirement.
