

Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) External Organization Guidance

Per the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), Title IV, Part B, 21st Century Community Learning Center (21st CCLC), the Kansas State Department of Education (KSDE) is required to provide a list of prescreened external organizations. The term "external organization" is defined, by ESSA, as: "(A) a nonprofit organization with a record of success in running or working with before and after school (or summer recess) programs and activities; or (B) in the case of a community where there is no such organization, a nonprofit organization in the community that enters into a written agreement or partnership with an organization described in subparagraph (A) to receive mentoring and guidance in running or working with before and after school (or summer recess) programs and activities" (ESSA, section 4201).

To meet the minimum requirements for the *record of success*, interested organizations must:

- Operate as a nonprofit in good standing in Kansas (as listed with the Kansas Secretary of State), and
- Have a minimum of two years' experience operating or delivering services to after school programs in Kansas.

Submission Requirements:

- Complete and submit an External Organization Profile (included).
- Submit a copy of the certificate of incorporation or similar document if it clearly establishes the nonprofit status of the organization.
- Profiles may be submitted at any time, there is no due date for submission. KSDE will review upon receipt.

Note: School districts (LEA's) should not complete this form; however, KSDE encourages LEA's and organizations to sharethis information with partners and other external organizations who work with youth during out-of-school times.

By meeting the record of success and submission requirements listed above, the organization will be included on a list of identified external organizations in Kansas on the KSDE 21st CCLC webpage.

Disclaimers:

- Any external organization that meets the record of success and submission criteria outlined above will be included on the external organization list maintained by KSDE upon receipt and verification of approval.
- No funding is directly associated with this Profile for inclusion on the external organization list. KSDE will not be providing funding to external organizations and the completion of this Profile will NOT result in a contract with KSDE.
- KSDE reserves the right to omit any organization at any time from the list for failure to meet the record of success requirements.
- KSDE does not guarantee the amount of work given, if any, to organizations on the
 external organization list. By including an organization on the external organization
 list, KSDE is simply verifying that the organization successfully completed the
 external organization prescreening process in compliance with ESSA.
- This list is not an exhaustive list. Inclusion of any organization on the external
 organization list is NOT an endorsement of the organization, nor is it a certification
 of the quality of activities provided by the organization.
- This is not an eligibility requirement to apply or participate in 21st CCLC programs or other out-of-school time programs.
- Inclusion of any organization on the external organization list will not provide for competitive advantages/disadvantages during any 21st CCLC grant competitions.
