Final allocations for 2024-2025 for all programs included in the LCP will be determined after we have received final state allocations from the U.S. Department of Education. You will be notified as soon as they are calculated. Please remember that the 2024-2025 LCP Assurances are due on June 7, 2024. The LCP Revision and Carryover is due on July 1, 2024. The LCP Annual Report is due on July 15, 2024. The due date for the 2024-2025 LCP Application is September 30, 2024.
