

Title IV, Part A

FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2022 TITLE IVA EXPENDITURE REPORTING

Purpose

In accordance with the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) §4104(a)(2), the Kansas State Department of Education must publicly report on how funds made available under Title IV, Part A are being expended by Local Education Agencies (LEAs).

Below is a summary of expenditures, as reported by LEAs, which describes funds spent from Federal Fiscal Award 2022 under each content area of the Title IVA grant. These reports are only regarding funds expended using federal Title IVA allocations.

- 1) **Well-Rounded Education (Section 4107)** Access to, and opportunities for a well-rounded education for all students.

 A minimum of 20% of Title IV, Part A grant funds **must** be used in this area if the district or consortium has an allocation over \$30,000.
- 2) Safe and Healthy Students (Section 4108) Improve school conditions for student learning in order to create a healthy and safe environment.

A minimum of 20% of Title IV, Part A grant funds must be used in this area if the district or consortium has an allocation over \$30,000.

3) **Support the Effective Use of Technology (Section 4109)** – Improve the use of technology in order to improve the academic achievement and digital literacy of all students.

A maximum of 15% of funds allocated in this content area may be used for technological infrastructure.

A portion of funds *must* be used in this area if the district or consortium has an allocation over \$30,000.

Reporting Exemptions

Please Note:

- Some LEAs consolidate the entirety of their Title IVA funds into other Title programs (Title I, Title IIA, Title III, Migrant) and in doing so those funds "lose" their identity as Title IVA funds which exempts them from the Title IVA Expenditure reporting. These LEAs are noted under the LEA Expenditure chart column "REAP, Transfer, Consortium, Release".
- Some LEAs joined a consortium, these are noted under the LEA Expenditure chart column, "REAP, Transfer, Consortium, Release".
- Some LEAs "released" funding back to the federal government, these are noted under the LEA Expenditure chart column, "REAP, Transfer, Consortium, Release".
- LEAs are allowed to select the area(s) in which they utilize their funding based on Title IV, Part A formula grant requirements. This is noted under the LEA Expenditure chart under each content area with \$0.
 - o Districts receiving less than \$30,000 must utilize funds in at least one of the three areas listed.
 - o Districts receiving \$30,000 or more must utilize funds in each of the three areas listed.
